We willingly accept our responsibility to pray for our church and its members, to participate regularly in its meetings, to use our abilities and spiritual gifts to serve one another, to witness faithfully to those outside the church, to contribute regularly to support the work of the church, and to be good stewards of our lives so we can fulfill these responsibilities.

In all things we seek to glorify our Lord Jesus Christ and to build up His church.
